Application Instructions – Assistant Professor:

1. The Department strongly encourages applicants to use the EconJobMarket website to submit their applications. Go to <https://econjobmarket.org/index.php> to set up your free account on [EconJobMarket.org](https://econjobmarket.org) (EJM).
2. Complete your profile:
 - a) When setting up your profile you will be asked for the highest level of education completed. Please put in the name of institution and date of graduation (or anticipated graduation) **of your PhD**, even if you have not completed it.
 - b) You will be asked to provide your primary and other research fields. Please choose the areas of research interest matching your CV, not the area closest to our advertised fields, unless they are one and the same. Your application will be read by faculty members closest to your field. If you indicate a field that does not match your CV and reference letters there will be a delay while your application is put aside for reassignment.
3. You will be asked to provide a CV, job market paper, a second paper (optional) and any other materials that you believe pertinent. You are asked to provide evidence of teaching effectiveness. Applicants for Assistant Professor positions may submit teaching evaluations or other evidence of teaching effectiveness if available. You will also be asked to specify who will be writing recommendation letters for you. Please have this material and information ready.
4. You will receive a username and PIN via email. Use this information to log-in to [EconJobMarket.org](https://econjobmarket.org) (<https://econjobmarket.org/index.php>).
5. From the main menu under Application, choose “New Application”, select our ad and click on “Apply Now.” We are advertising for Assistant and Associate positions. Please choose the correct position.

The [Vancouver School of Economics](#) at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver Campus invites applications for up to 2 tenure-track positions at the level of Assistant Professor. Starting date: July 1, 2017. We are seeking outstanding candidates primarily in the fields of Public Economics, Economic History, Labour Economics and Behavioural/Experimental Economics but in truly exceptional cases, candidates working outside of these fields may be given consideration. Positions are subject to final budgetary approval.

Qualifications: For appointment at the Assistant Professor level, the candidate must have a Ph.D. (or solid indication of imminent completion) in a relevant field, and demonstrate excellence or clear promise of excellence in teaching and in research. The successful candidate will be expected to maintain an active program of research, teaching, graduate supervision, and service. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Applications must include a c.v., evidence of teaching effectiveness, samples of research papers, and at least three confidential reference letters which must be submitted directly by the referee. All application materials and reference letters should be submitted by **November 15, 2016**. Review of applications will begin immediately following this date.
