

Vancouver School of Economics
Application Instructions – Associate Professor:

1. The Department strongly encourages applicants to use the EconJobMarket website to submit their applications. Go to <https://econjobmarket.org/index.php> to set up your free account on EconJobMarket.org (EJM).
2. Complete your profile:
 - a) When setting up your profile you will be asked for the highest level of education completed. Please put in the name of institution and date of graduation **of your PhD**.
 - b) You will be asked to provide your primary and other research fields. Please choose the areas of research interest matching your CV. Your application will be read by faculty members closest to your field. If you indicate a field that does not match your CV there will be a delay while your application is put aside for reassignment.
3. You will be asked to provide a CV, job market paper, a second paper (optional) and any other materials that you believe pertinent. You are asked to provide evidence of teaching effectiveness. Applicants for Associate/Full Professor positions should submit teaching evaluations (and other evidence of teaching effectiveness if available). Please have this material and information ready.

You will also be asked to specify who will be writing recommendation letters for you. This is an automatic feature of EconJobMarket. While you are welcome to complete this section, it is not necessary. If you are shortlisted we will ask you for a list of arm's length* referees which the department may contact for an evaluation of your work.

4. You will receive a username and PIN via email. Use this information to log-in to EconJobMarket.org (<https://econjobmarket.org/index.php>).
5. From the main menu under Application, choose “New Application”, select our ad and click on “Apply Now.” We are advertising for Assistant and Associate positions. Please choose the correct position. (Our ad can be found at: <https://www.econjobmarket.org/postings.php?posid=3941>)
6. The completed application on EJM will be transferred to us and processed. If you have questions, or if you wish to submit your application by mail, contact Anne Coates. (anne.coates[at]ubc[dot]ca)
7. To ensure full consideration, applications must be submitted at <http://econjobmarket.org> by **November 15, 2016**. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted regarding an interview and/or visit to the department.

*Candidates for Associate or Full Professor must be approved by the VSE Standing Committee on Promotion and Tenure and the Senior Appointments Committee before an official appointment can be offered. Applicants considered for appointment to a tenured position will be asked to provide a list of at least 4 referees. Referees should be at arm's length; that is, referees should be persons whose impartiality cannot be doubted. They may not include such categories as relatives, close personal friends, clients, former graduate thesis advisers, research supervisors, and should not include current or former colleagues where conflict of interest cannot be managed, grant co-holders or co-authors.

The [Vancouver School of Economics](#) at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver Campus invites applications for a senior professorial position, primarily at the Associate Professor level but we may also consider truly exceptional candidates for appointment at the level of Professor. Our priority fields are Public Economics, Economic History, Labour Economics and Behavioural/Experimental Economics, however truly exceptional candidates working outside these fields may be given consideration. Starting date: July 1, 2017. The successful candidate will be appointed to the rank appropriate to their level of experience. Positions are subject to final budgetary approval.

Qualifications: For appointment at the Associate or Full Professor level, the candidate must have a Ph.D., a distinguished international reputation, an outstanding record of publications in top-ranked journals, a proven record of excellence in teaching, and a track record of effective Ph.D. supervision. The successful candidate will be expected to maintain an active program of research, teaching, graduate supervision, and service. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Applications must include a c.v., evidence of teaching effectiveness, and samples of research papers. We require the names and contact information of at least 4 potential referees who can be contacted for an evaluation of the applicant's work, should the applicant be shortlisted. All application materials should be submitted by **November 15, 2016**. Review of applications will begin immediately following this date.
